1 The Court has considered IPPs' Administrative Motion to Submit Detailed Expense  
2 Records For *In Camera* Review ("Motion") and the supporting Declaration.

3 IPPs explained that portions of these records pertaining to expert invoices from 1)  
4 Monument Economics Group, 2) Nathan Associates, Inc., and 3) OSKR contain information  
5 protected by the attorney-client privilege and attorney work-product doctrine, and that redaction  
6 of these voluminous records is impractical. Therefore, IPPs will submit for *in camera* submission  
7 a compendium of detailed expense records pertaining to expert invoices from 1) Monument  
8 Economics Group, 2) Nathan Associates, Inc., and 3) OSKR in chronological order received  
9 from each, and as identified in the Summary of Incurred Litigation Fund Costs attached to the  
10 Declaration of Adam Zapala in Support of Indirect Purchaser Plaintiffs' Motion for an Award of  
11 Attorneys' Fees, Reimbursement of Expenses, and Class Representative Service Awards.

12 The Court finds that there are sufficient grounds for the motion, and hereby GRANTS  
13 IPPs' request. IPPs may submit their detailed expense records pertaining to expert invoices from  
14 1) Monument Economics Group, 2) Nathan Associates, Inc., and 3) OSKR *in camera*.
